Besides being very busy as a working musician Bastian is a renowned EDUCATOR: He teaches at the University of Music Wuerzburg.

By now, Bastian Juette recorded more than 80 CDs as a sideman, five as a bandleader.

He plays in a lot of different groups and worked with MUSICIANS like Seamus Blake, David Binney, Rick Margitza, Vincent Herring, Maria Schneider, Nguyên Lê, Don Friedman, Ack von Rooyen, Michael Wollny, Johannes Enders, Adrian Mears, Henning Sieverts, Frank Moebus, Klaus Doldinger, Jiggs Wiggham, the SWR Big Band...
